- Set up an account at Goodreads.com (work with a parent!)
- Add any books you read and finish this summer & rate them!
- Options for fun: Write reviews of the books you read, add books you might want to read in the future, and find your friends on Goodreads and follow them.

When we arrive at school again in August, we will all become GoodReads friends with one another so that we can share the books we like.

## 2.) Play some summer reading bingo

This is the hope I have for your reading life: that you will find books that you enjoy reading, and that you will read often. To help you explore a variety of books this summer, we'll play a little game of summer reading bingo. Anyone who "wins" can expect a prize!

Here are the rules of the game:

- You can use the same book for no more than three squares (EX: If you read a classic via audiobook that your grandmother recommended, that can count for "Classic", "Audiobook", and "Recommended by an adult".)
- Winning the game = completing 12 or more squares.
- Anyone who completes EVERY square will receive a Grand Prize.

You will turn in your bingo card during the first week of school.
