Each child should have read one of these two books. The book report will be completed during the first week here at school.

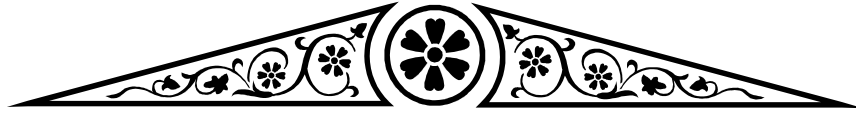
