2) In addition to any general review you choose to do, you MUST also complete the attached summer homework in the month it is assigned. Each month is considered a night of homework for the first week of school. The charts are due the first day of Spanish class and we will have a review test in September, so be prepared.

Do this homework online. The easiest way to access these links is to go to our PBWorks page, sracorinna.pbworks.com. At the bottom of the page, click on Las Tareas de Verano: Rising 8th Graders. That will take you to this information.

After completing each activity, fill in the chart showing when you did the work and have a parent sign and date the chart. If you do poorly on any scored activity, (fewer than seven out of ten or approximately 70 percent correct), read over your notes (vocabulary or grammar) for that section, and then do it again.

If, during one of the three months of summer, you cannot go online to do these activities, please have your parents make note of that when they sign and date your sheet. We prefer you to spread the homework out over three months if possible.

3) Summer Reading. You must read the book **Pobre Ana** and write a 3-5 paragraph summary of the entire book. You should write roughly 250 words using the same clear structure you have mastered in your reading summaries throughout the year: introductory and concluding paragraphs, as well as at least one body paragraph. The graded summary will be due the first day of Spanish class and will count as your first reading grade. Late summaries will be docked 10 points.
