FULL-TIME MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH TEACHER POSITION

St. Michael's Episcopal School seeks a qualified full-time middle school math teacher for the 2019-2020 academic year. The Middle School employs the International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Program, which emphasizes interdisciplinary learning to assist students in making practical connections between their studies and the real world. This is a ten-month position beginning in July.

The successful candidate will have...

- excellent verbal and written skills and ability to communicate with students, parents and colleagues;
- a minimum of 3 years of experience teaching (preferably in middle school) math;
- a bachelor's degree in education, math, or a related field. An advanced degree is preferred, though not required.

The ideal candidate will have...

- used a variety of instructional strategies and assessment methods to meet the cognitive and affective needs of all students;
- worked cooperatively with colleagues on a consistent basis;
- integrated technology effectively into student learning;
- demonstrated kindness, enthusiasm, a sense of humor, investment in continued learning and professional growth, and a passion for supporting children as they grow and learn;
- worked actively to cultivate an inclusive environment and support a school community grounded in empathy, social responsibility, and an appreciation and respect for individual differences;
- employed effective classroom management skills;
- demonstrated an embrace of the IB approach to learning as well as a track record of modeling the characteristics detailed in the IB learner profile;
- mentored middle school-aged students to support their personal and social-emotional growth;
- demonstrated success in significantly growing students' capacity to communicate in a variety of forms, lead among them writing;
- maintained accurate and timely documentation of grades, behavior, academic concerns, and parent communication;
- directed/coached school activities/clubs/sports outside of the classroom.

St. Michael's Episcopal School provides children with superior academic instruction in an environment that acknowledges and develops the Christian values of kindness, respect, acceptance, integrity, responsibility, resilience, and compassion.
