Visit each page in the given month, do the tasks, and let us know when you have done them. That means you must LEAVE A NOTE telling us when you have done the activity. The activities are numbered, so just say, "did #1" etc. The idea is to keep your Spanish brain from falling to sleep over the summer. If you do poorly on any scored activity, (fewer than seven out of ten or approximately 70 percent correct), you may wish to read over your notes (vocabulary or grammar) for that section, and then try it again.

If, during one of the three months of summer, you can't do the work assigned for that month, please have your parents write you a note to bring to school in August. We prefer you to spread the homework over three months, but we understand that is not always possible.
