



ST. MICHAEL'S EPISCOPAL SCHOOL ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

Thank you for your interest in St. Michael's Episcopal School.

Below is a checklist of the items needed for your child's application to be considered for admission.

<u>Kindergarten</u>	
<input type="checkbox"/> Application <i>First round priority deadline is Dec 15, 2022</i>	Complete the online application found on our website: stmschool.net/admissions/process/#process <i>\$50 non-refundable application fee must be submitted with the application</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> Release Form	Complete and sign the Release Form . St. Michael's will request a Preschool Report directly from your child's teacher in December.
<input type="checkbox"/> Testing Preference Form	Complete the Testing Preference Form , indicating where you wish to have your child's WPPSI-IV testing done. The WPPSI (<i>Wechsler Preschool & Primary Scale of Intelligence</i>) is an individual assessment, administered by a licensed psychologist, that measures the cognitive abilities of young children.
<input type="checkbox"/> WPPSI-IV Cognitive Abilities Testing	Schedule your child's WPPSI-IV testing. The WPPSI may be scheduled at St. Michael's, beginning in October, for a fee of \$150, at another participating independent school, or privately through a practitioner of your choosing.
<input type="checkbox"/> Readiness Testing	Register for Readiness Testing at St. Michael's in January (registration information TBA). This assessment allows your child to meet individually with one of our kindergarten teachers and demonstrate his or her Pre-K skills.
<i>St. Michael's Episcopal School requires that all enrolled students be currently vaccinated as prescribed by the Commonwealth of Virginia.</i>	

Applications must be submitted by **December 15, 2022** to be considered in our first round of admission decisions. All requirements for the application process must be completed by **February 1, 2023**. First-round notifications will be sent electronically at **3 p.m. on Friday, February 17, 2023**. Admissions decisions will continue on a rolling basis through the spring as space allows.
