- 1 small (one-inch) 3-ring binder
$\square 1$ large (two-inch) 3-ring binder We prefer students not use zipper binders. These are challenging to keep organized and typically do not fit in backpacks.
$\square$ set of 5 tab dividers (write-on tabs) for binder
$\square$ set of 8 tab dividers (write-on tabs) for binder
$\square 1$ pack notebook paper: 150-sheet pack, college ruled
$\square 2$ five-subject spiral notebooks (wide or college-ruled)
$\square 1$ durable, soft pencil case with holes (must fit in binder)
- 3 Mead composition notebooks (100 pages sewn binding) - any color
- 40-50 \#2 wooden pencils (not mechanical pencils; at least 5 sharpened on first day)
$\square$ 15-25 eraser caps
$\square$ plastic pencil sharpener with receptacle (no battery-powered sharpeners)
$\square$ 2-3 highlighters (at least 2 different colors)
- 1 package of colored pencils (8-12 count)
$\square 1$ black, ultra fine-point Sharpie (or other permanent-marking pen)
$\square 1$ pair of scissors
$\square 1$ large eraser
$\square 2$ glue sticks
$\square 1$ roll Scotch tape
$\square 1$ set headphones/earbuds (to be kept at school)
$\square 1$ personal sized container of UNSCENTED hand sanitizer
$\square$ backpack
$\square$ Soft sided lunchbox (An old one is great!) or a plastic box with lid to hold supplies
$\square 1$ box plastic forks (students with last names A-H)
$\square 1$ box plastic spoons (students with last names I-P)
