WRITING: Summer is a great time to keep a journal filled with activities, travels, fun, and personal thoughts. It's a terrific way to improve writing skills, develop voice, and practice grammar skills. Check out the writing choices if you need ideas!

<u>MATH</u>: Please complete at least 7 tasks on the **Math Activities Bingo Board**. Fact fluency is necessary for higher-level computation and problem solving. Rising fourth graders are expected to know multiplication facts through 12x12 and their related division facts. Students may wish to practice these facts over the summer and are welcome to use IXL for this purpose and for additional skills practice.
