

Thank you for your interest in St. Michael's Episcopal School. Below is a checklist of the items needed for your child's application to be considered for admission for the 2024-2025 school year.

## Lower School: Grades 1-5

Application	Complete the <u>online application</u> \$50 non-refundable application fee must be submitted with the application
Transcript Release Form	Complete and sign the <u>Transcript Release Form</u> . St. Michael's will request transcripts and a teacher recommendation directly from your child's current school in January.
Testing Preference Form	Complete the <u>Testing Preference Form</u> . This form indicates where you wish to have your child's WISC-V testing done. The WISC ( <i>Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children</i> ) is an individual assessment, administered by a licensed psychologist, and measures cognitive abilities.
WISC-V Cognitive Abilities Testing	Schedule your child's WISC-V testing. The WISC-V may be scheduled at St. Michael's for a fee of \$150, another independent school, or privately through a practitioner of your choosing.
Visit Day and Skills Assessment	Our team will work with your family to schedule a visit for your child. These visits typically start at the beginning of January. During this all-day visit, your child will be matched with a student host and have the opportunity to experience a day in the life of a St. Michael's student, and to learn more about the School. Your child will also complete a grade-level academic assessment as part of the visit.
St. Michael's Episcopal School requires that all enrolled students be currently vaccinated as prescribed by the Commonwealth of Virginia.	

Applications for Grades 1-5 are considered on a rolling basis with initial decisions made in February. We recommend that you submit an application for these grades **by December 15**. Decisions will continue throughout the spring and summer as space permits.
