## **School Supplies**

- College-ruled notebook paper, multiple packages to be used in all subjects all year
- 1/4 " quadrille graphing paper
- Pencil case
- 2 boxes #2 pencils (if mechanical, please bring additional lead)
- Correction tape
- Ballpoint pens (black, blue, red for correcting papers)
- 1 box 10 count broad tip colored markers
- 1 box 24 count colored pencils
- 3 highlighters, different colors
- 2 Sharpies (1 fine point, 1 regular)
- 1 pair of scissors

- 6" ruler
- Mini dry erase board
