ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

Thank you for your interest in St. Michael's Episcopal School. Below is a checklist of the items needed for your child's application to be considered for admission for the 2026-2027 school year.

Lower School: Grades 1-5

<input type="checkbox"/>	Step 1: Complete the Online Application The recommended application deadline for grades 1-5 is February 1 . A \$50 non-refundable application fee must be submitted with the application.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Step 2: Complete and Sign the Release Form St. Michael's will request transcripts and a teacher recommendation directly from your child's current school in January.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Step 3: Complete the Testing Preference Form This form indicates where you wish to have your child's WISC-V testing done. The WISC (<i>Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children, Fifth Edition</i>) is an individual assessment, administered by a licensed psychologist, that measures cognitive abilities in children ages 6-16.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Step 4: Schedule your child's WISC-V Testing The WISC-V may be scheduled at St. Michael's, for a fee of \$150, at another independent school, or privately through a practitioner of your choosing. If testing at St. Michael's, our team will reach out to schedule that appointment.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Step 5: Schedule your child's Visit Day In January, we will work with your family to schedule your child's visit day. During this all-day visit (half day for rising first and second grade students), your child will be matched with a student host and will have the opportunity to experience a "day in the life" at St. Michael's. Your child will also complete grade-level academic assessments as part of their visit.
<i>St. Michael's Episcopal School requires that all enrolled students be currently vaccinated as prescribed by the Commonwealth of Virginia.</i>	

Our natural entry points are Kindergarten and Sixth Grade. However, we always welcome applications to non-entry point grades, and new students will be considered in other grade levels as space permits. The recommended application deadline for grades 1-5 is **February 1**. Initial decisions are made after February 14 and will continue on a rolling basis.
