ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

Thank you for your interest in St. Michael's Episcopal School. Below is a checklist of the items needed for your child's application to be considered for admission for the 2026-2027 school year.

Middle School: Grades 6-7



Step 1: Complete the [Online Application](#)

Applications must be submitted **by January 25** to be considered in our first round of admission decisions. A \$50 non-refundable application fee must be submitted with the application.



Step 2: Complete and Sign the [Release Form](#)

St. Michael's will request transcripts and a teacher recommendation directly from your child's current school at the end of January.



Step 3: Complete the [Testing Preference Form](#)

This form indicates where you wish to have your child's WISC-V testing done. The WISC (*Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children, Fifth Edition*) is an individual assessment, administered by a licensed psychologist, that measures cognitive abilities in children ages 6-16.



Step 4: Schedule your child's WISC-V Testing

The WISC-V may be scheduled at St. Michael's, for a fee of \$150, at another independent school, or privately through a practitioner of your choosing. If testing at St. Michael's, our team will reach out to schedule that appointment.



Step 5: Schedule your child's Visit Day

Starting in January, we will work with your family to schedule your child's visit day. During this all-day visit, your child will be matched with a student host and will have the opportunity to experience a "day in the life" at St. Michael's. Your child will also complete grade-level academic assessments as part of their visit.

St. Michael's Episcopal School requires that all enrolled students be currently vaccinated as prescribed by the Commonwealth of Virginia.

*Applications must be submitted by **January 25, 2026** to be considered in our first round of admission decisions. All requirements for the application process must be completed by **February 20, 2026**. Initial admission decisions for Middle School applicants will be made the first week in March, and families will be notified electronically. Admission decisions will continue on a rolling basis through the spring as space allows.*
